

What to expect in a day at IAFP

First Day and Pre-Meeting Activities

- Go to the registration booth to pick up your materials and badge.
- Workshops are held Friday–Saturday (July 12–13) and require registration in advance.
- A welcome reception is hosted Saturday evening (July 13).
- PDG meetings and other committees meet on Sunday, July 14. Join a [PDG](#) today!
- The meeting begins at the Ivan Parkin Opening Session, which is followed by a reception.

Meeting Days

- Customize your meeting schedule with the IAFP meeting app!
- The meeting includes symposia, roundtables, technical presentations, and poster sessions. A typical day involves a mixture of these sessions and breaks. More details can be found online.
- You can move between rooms and sessions as you wish.
- Exhibit hall receptions are held on Monday and Tuesday evenings.
- Posters are hung in the exhibit hall and can be viewed during breaks and receptions.
- The last day of the meeting includes sessions and the John H. Siliker Lecture, followed by an awards banquet.
